- The entry theme must convey a "Keep North Dakota's Trails and Parks Clean" message.
- Entries must be created using digital media, such as: Adobe Illustrator, Pagemaker, Publisher, etc.
- Entry **MUST** be an original student created (in grades 9-12) artwork. Unauthorized use of clip art or photographs is prohibited.
- Files may be submitted in 30 second long wmv, mpeg, or 300 dpi jpeg or gif formats.
- **Any North Dakota student in grades 9-12 interested in participating may submit one entry.** There is no requirement for a school to send in only one winning entry per school.
- There must be a completed Entry Form accompanying the artwork.
- All entries will become the property of KNDC for litter prevention and education purposes.
